~**Start** From the Mary Ann Reserve (affectionately known by locals as the rec) canoe upriver past The Pretoria Hotel a further 350m will take you past the Murray St Boat Ramp-opp The Mannum Hotel
~Paddle another 150m you will canoe past the PS Marion a lovingly restored paddle steamer (remember after your canoe to re visit the Dock Museum and Visitor Information Centre to find out about the history of Mannum.

~Take care crossing the ferry crossing. Paddle a further 75m on your right you will see the old ferry uprights at the start of the Mannum Caravan Park.....

Just before you go.....

Caring for the River Murray and the Lower lakes while enjoying the many recreational opportunities available, will ensure that present and future generations can enjoy these wonderful places for many years.

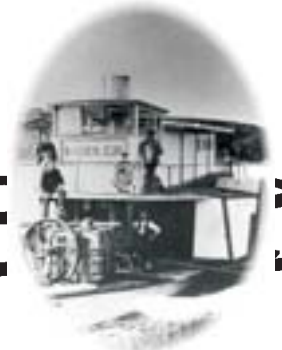
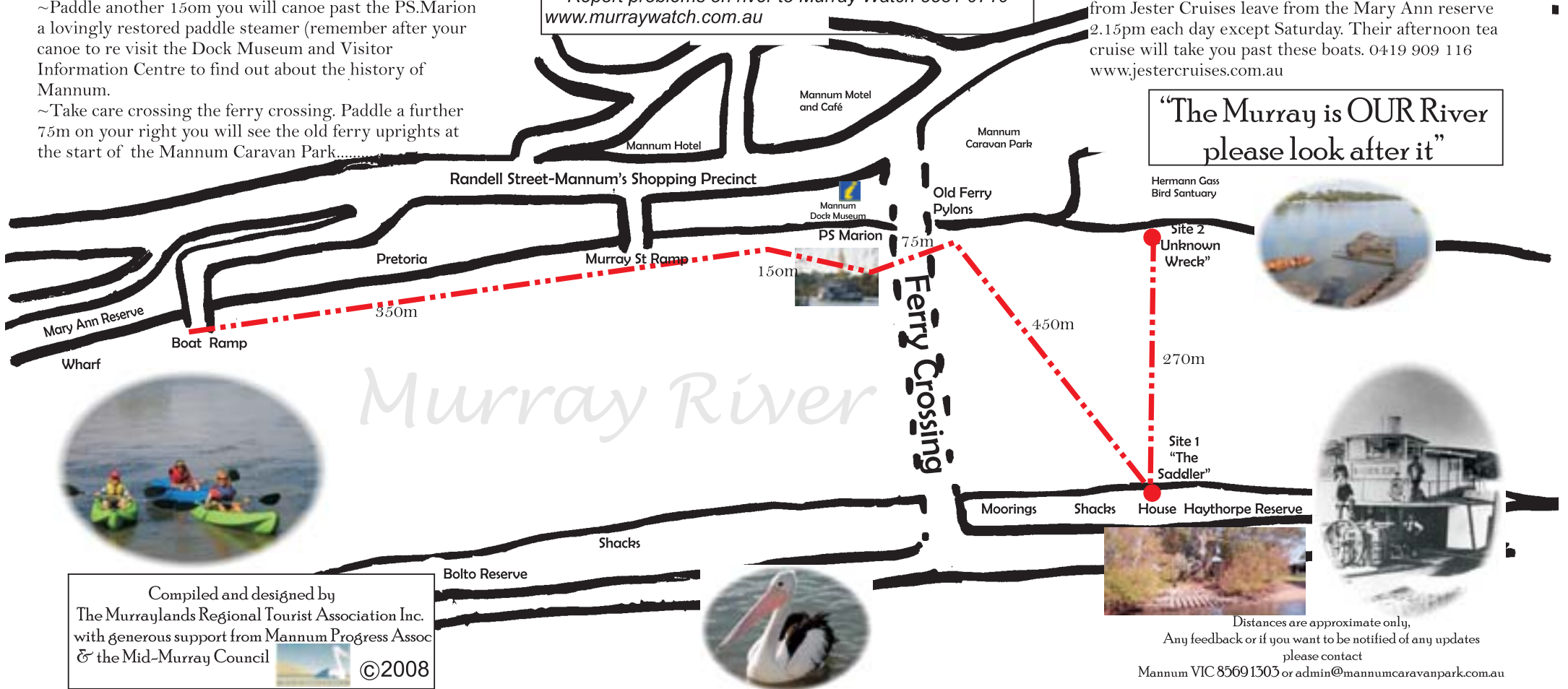

PLEASE NOTE:

- Always wear an approved PFD
- Be sunsafe wear a hat at sunscreen
- Take plenty of fresh water
- Take any rubbish home with you
- Follow all river users rules- When crossing ferry move to middle of river wait until ferries are at side of river this means cables are at their lowest point. Then cross.
- Pick up a sustainable recreation guide-How to have fun with minimal impact on the River Murray.

.....continuing your canoe experience
~After crossing with care over the ferry crossing take a course diagonally across the river 450m there on the bank you will see the remains of the "Saddler"-Visit the Dock Museum for more information on the Saddler.(This is private property we ask you to remain in your canoe and take only pictures.)

~Cross back over the River 270m you will see(at the end of the first stance of willows) the remains of an unidentified boat-still partially submerged-It was hoped we may have found the final resting place of the Mary Ann(guess we will still have to keep looking for that one.)
~HAVEN'T GOT A CANOE -Not a problem You can hire one locally.(Breeze Hire 0438 802 668 or SA ski boat centre- forcurrent contacts at the information centre) If you would like to view these wrecks Helen and Jeff from Jester Cruises leave from the Mary Ann reserve 2.15pm each day except Saturday. Their afternoon tea cruise will take you past these boats. 0419 909 116 www.jestercruises.com.au
